



2008 Chardonnay, Paso Robles

12.9 % alc., 112 Cases Produced

The 2008 Chardonnay was made from grapes we purchased from a neighboring vineyard. The grapes were fermented in stainless steel, then transferred into neutral oak where it laid to rest for another 10 months. The result is a very crisp and clean wine, where the acid is present, but the time on neutral oak really rounds the palate out. Possessing a beautiful light golden hue, the nose of this Chardonnay is very subtle, with nuances of baked pear, gala apples and a slight mineral note. The palate confirms these flavors but adds to it a kiss of butterscotch...
